You could see yourself working as a coach professionally, either besides your current role or even fulltime – once you've deepened your coaching experience



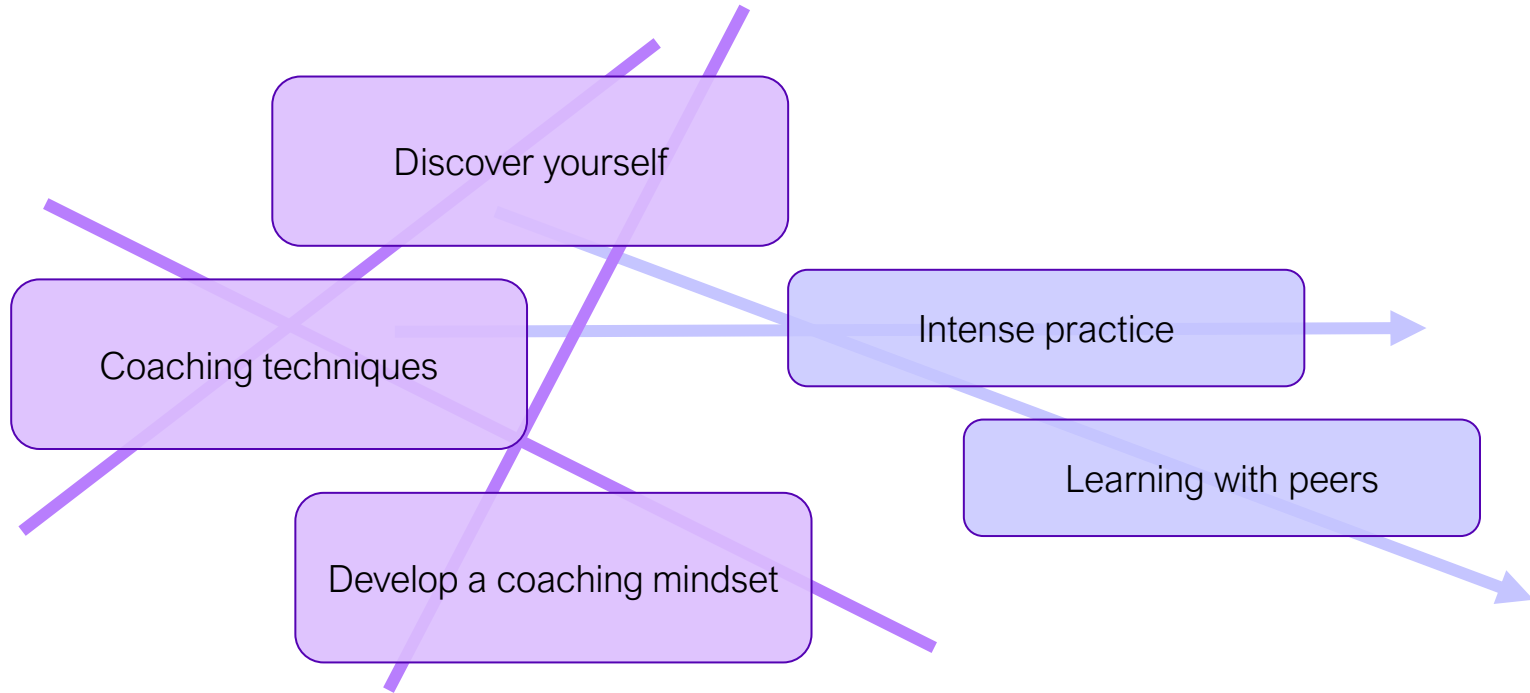
Personal growth

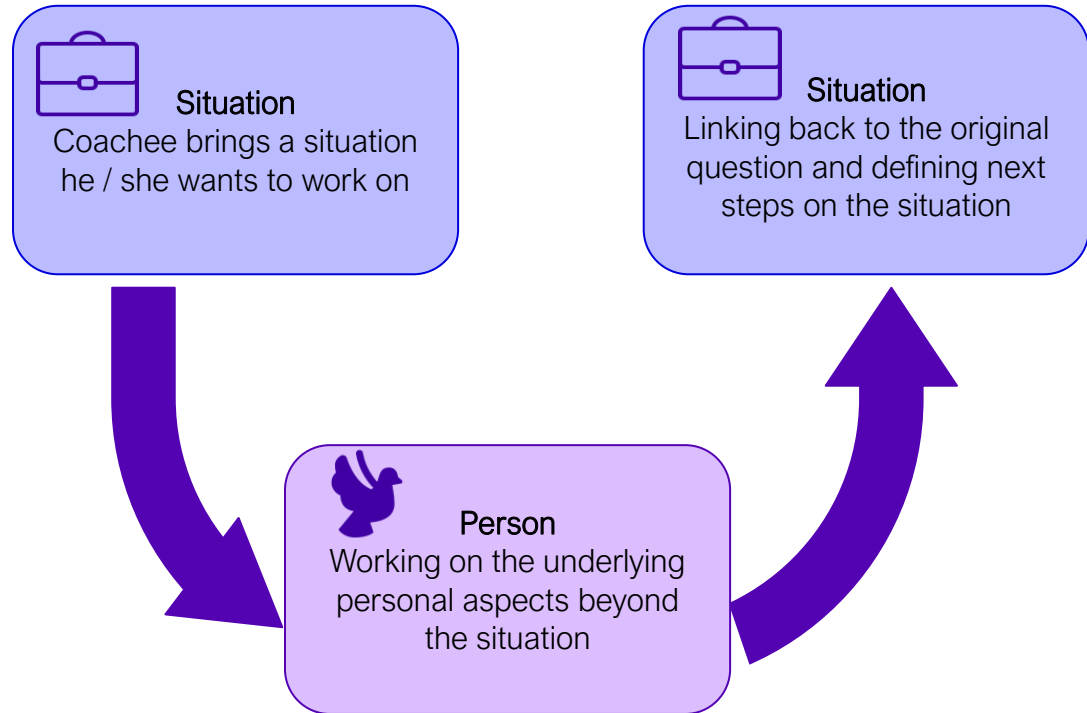

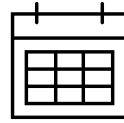

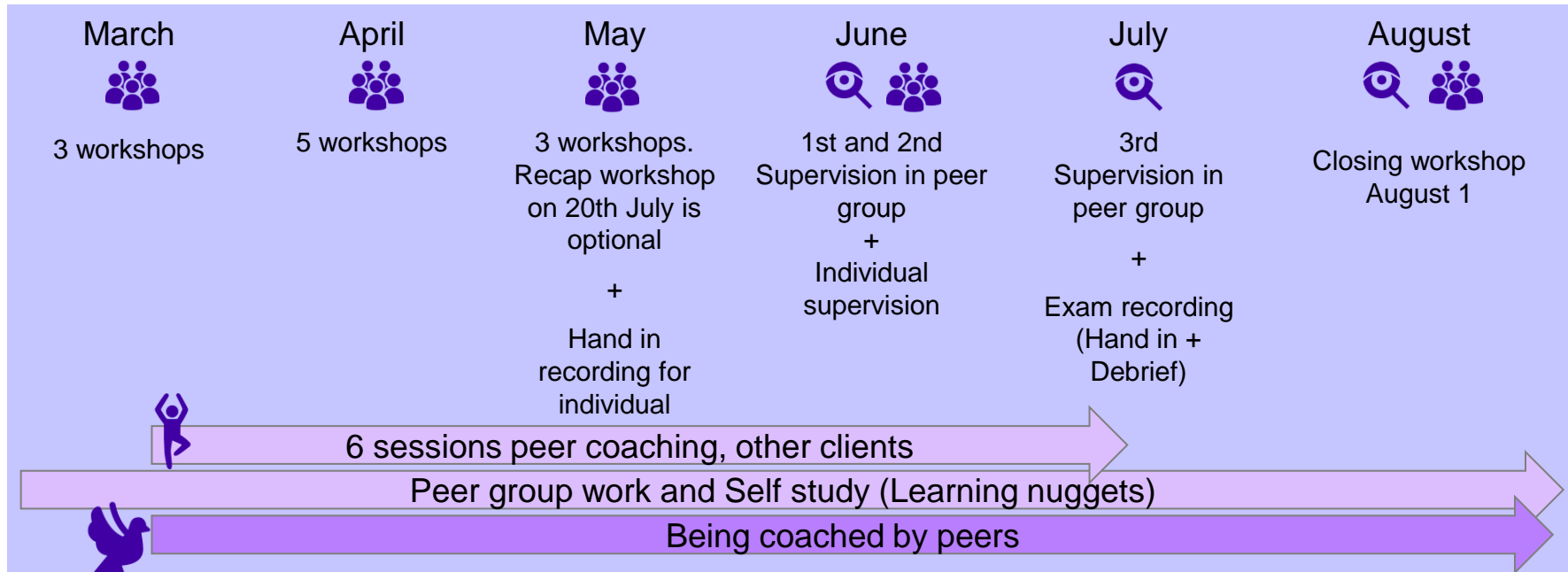
First learning, then supervision!



 Learning: 11 workshops from March to May, closing workshop in early August
Workshops only on Thursdays between 17:30-20:30 CET

 Practice: 6 sessions from March to mid-July

 Supervision: 2 individual and 3 group sessions from June to July

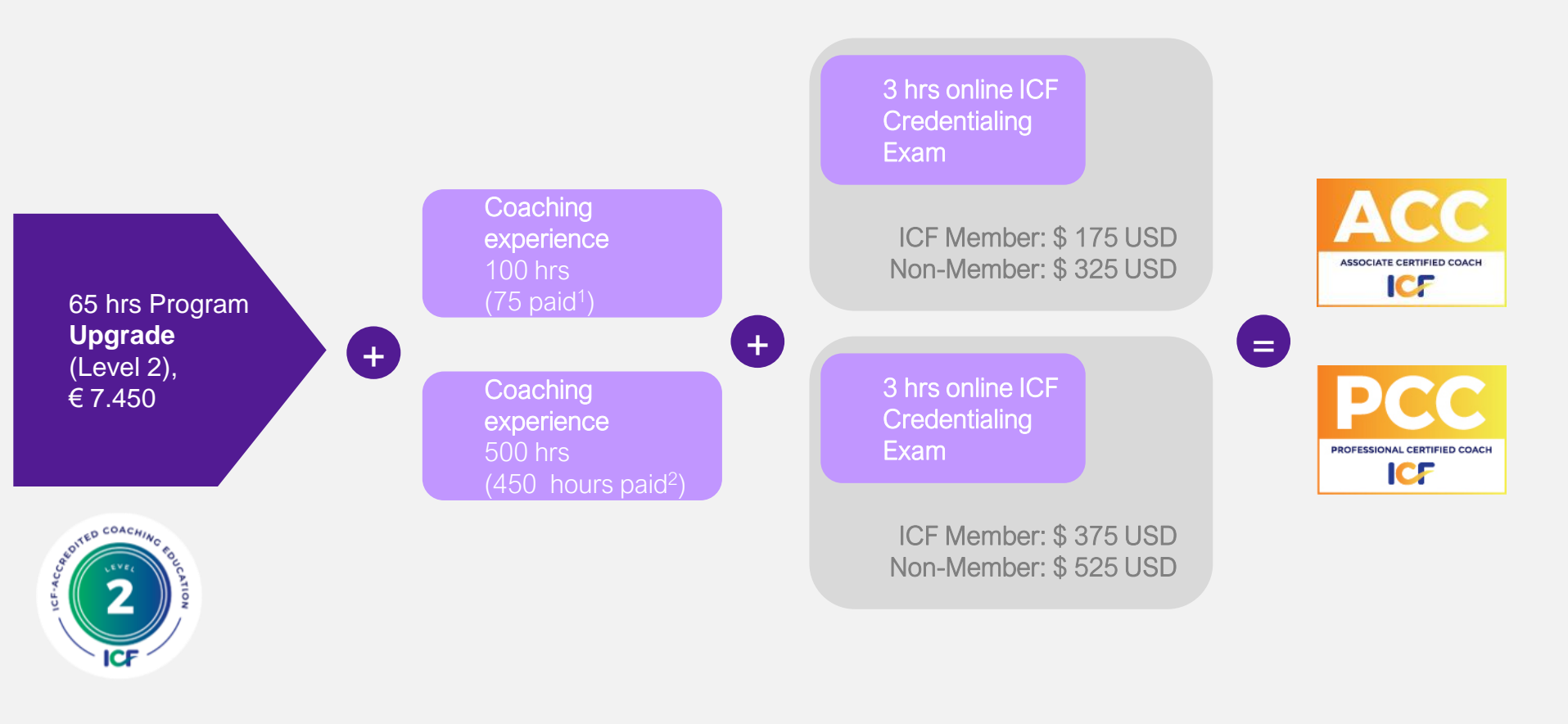
In addition to the Level 1 Program with us, you need 2 more elements to obtain ACC from ICF



1) 100 hrs to claim a personal ACC credential with ICF can be collected from day 1 of our coach training as we are accredited. However, they may not be part of the 60 hrs but must be on top
2) 75 hours paid coaching (Paid: salary, barter deals and low payment), 8 clients min. At least 25 of these hours (paid or unpaid) must occur within the 18 months prior to submitting the application for the credential.
3) Retake costs 105 US\$ with ICF



Alternatively, you continue your education and become PCC (optionally ACC first)



- 1) 75 hours must be paid coaching
- 2) 450 hours paid coaching (Paid: salary, barter deals and low payment), 25 clients min. 50 hours must have occurred within the 18 months prior to submitting the credential application. At least 450 of the hours must be paid.
- 3) Retake costs 105 US\$ with ICF
